CHARTER

The Kiwanis Club Foundation, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska was chartered by the State of Nebraska effective March 1, 1960 by members of the Kiwanis Club of Lincoln, Nebraska.

TAX STATUS

The Kiwanis Club Foundation, Inc. of Lincoln, Nebraska is a nonprofit corporation exempt from state taxation pursuant to statute and federal taxation pursuant to Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). The federal identification number is 47-6038422. The foundation is pleased to accept gifts of cash or other property to be used for its charitable purposes. Please consult your tax advisor regarding the proper handling of any donations.

PURPOSE

To accept gifts, contributions, grants, funds and bequests of real and personal property and to hold, administer, invest, reinvest and expend the same for any program or purpose that is determined by its Board of Trustees as useful or helpful to the Kiwanis Club of Lincoln, Nebraska in pursuit of the Club's charitable and community service objectives.

HISTORY

From the early 1920's the Kiwanis Club of Lincoln owned and maintained Camp Kiwanis near Milford, Nebraska as a part of its program to be of service to the young people in the Lincoln area.

When the Club's focus on it's many worthwhile projects in Lincoln and Lancaster County made it unreasonable to focus as much volunteer labor and money as needed to maintain a first rate camp, the camp was sold in 1983 to the Nebraska Easter Seal Society which was the exclusive user of the camp at that time. The sale proceeds provided the initial funding for the Kiwanis Club Foundation, Inc. of Lincoln.

GIFTS & GRANTS

The Foundation receives gifts and grants in support of community service projects, and continues to welcome additional gifts to be used for such purposes.

Donations can fund the Foundation's general purpose or, in certain instances, a donor's specific purpose. You may make cash or property gifts or bequests. Property in the form of stock certificates and other securities, as well as life insurance proceeds or cash values, whether all or only a portion thereof, can be transferred to the Foundation. Some Kiwanians pledge annual payments for a set or indefinite period. A gift can be made as an endowment with only the income used for the donor's purpose. Special arrangements can be made for donors who wish to establish a charitable annuity.

TRANSACTIONS

The Board of Trustees has the responsibility to manage the property and funds held by the Foundation. The trustees are further charged to invest the assets in such securities as are approved by not less than a majority of the Board. To the extent consistent with the Foundation's purposes and procedures, property and income from gifts made for a specified purpose shall be administered in accordance with terms and conditions imposed by the donor and devoted exclusively to the accomplishment of such purpose or purposes.

TRUSTEE GUIDELINES

Service projects considered by the Foundation shall substantially meet the following criteria:

1. Grants shall be made to organizations which serve the needs of Lancaster County; however, there may be instances where an organization from another county serves or has a "community of interest" with Lancaster County.
2. Projects which shall be considered by the Foundation should be directed towards meeting the needs of youth, recreation and education. Projects which serve low-income or needy individuals will also be considered.
3. Service projects must be determined by the Board of Trustees as useful or helpful to the Kiwanis Club of Lincoln in carrying out the Club's charitable and community service objectives.



TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees consists of not less than twelve members of the Kiwanis Club of Lincoln. Four trustees are elected at the Club's annual meeting every two years. Terms are for six years, and Trustees may be reelected for a second term. Trustees are not eligible for additional terms until a lapse of two years following their second term. The Secretary-Treasurer of the Foundation, elected by the Board, is an ex officio and has a vote.
